We are following up with you from the Part III Cox® Seminar in Fort Wayne a couple weeks ago. At that seminar, **Dr. Ralph Kruse** presented one of the several papers he and Dr. Sharina were working on at the time of her untimely death on June 23, 2007. The desire to "do something" in her memory by so many was presented to **Dr. Ram Gudavalli, Dr. Sharina's father and flexion-distraction's principal researcher**. Dr. Ram took time to consider what might be most appropriate.

At the seminar, **Dr. Cox** announced that a table would be placed in a clinic that served a community's less fortunate and that he would be the first to **donate \$1000** to this memorial.
